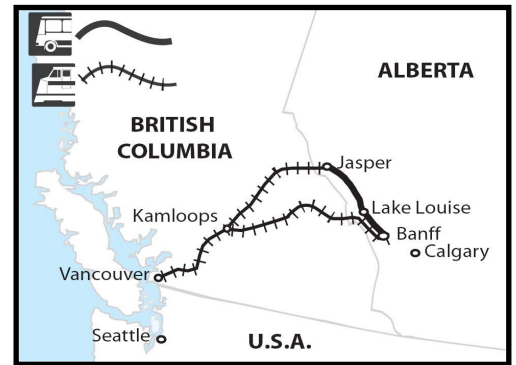

# Explorer's Circle from Vancouver

## Itinerary

### Day 1 - Vancouver

Upon arrival at the Vancouver International Airport transfer independently, by city transit service, limousine or taxi to downtown Vancouver (transfer not included). This evening, visit Vancouver's newest attraction, FlyOver Canada **(included)**. At its core, FlyOver Canada is a breathtaking, all-ages, flight simulation ride like no other! You will take off into a huge dome screen with the latest in projection and ride technology creating a true flying experience (complete with wind, scents, and mist!).

### Day 2 - VIA Rail to Jasper

Spend the day at leisure exploring the city. Take an optional tour of the city, walk along the sea wall or perhaps visit the Vancouver Aquarium. This evening, transfer by taxi **(included)** to Vancouver's Pacific Central Station and board VIA Rail's "Canadian" for your journey to Jasper. This experience, with its award-winning service, is luxury on rail. Points of interest include Hell's Gate (gorge), Suicide Rapids in the North Thompson Canyon, and the Cisco Tunnels above the Fraser River. **Please note that dinner is not included onboard the train this evening.**

### Day 3 - Jasper (B, L)

Today, travel between the Monashee and Cariboo mountain ranges before ending your train journey in the resort town of Jasper. **Breakfast and lunch are included onboard the train today.** Upon arrival at the Jasper train station, a motor coach or taxi will transfer you to your hotel **(transfer included)**.

### Day 4 - Jasper to Banff (L)

Today's journey travels south along the famous Icefields Parkway, one of the most spectacular highways in North America. This excursion to Banff also takes you through Jasper and Banff National Parks with stops at the newly opened Glacier Skywalk and the Columbia Icefield. The Glacier Skywalk is Jasper National Parks' newest attraction **(admission included)**. Winner of the 2011 World Architecture Future Projects award, the Glacier Skywalk consists of a 400 metre interpretive boardwalk and a glass-floored observation platform extending 30 metres out over the Sunwapta Valley. The walkway contains interpretive stations highlighting the ecology, geology, glaciology, Aboriginal history and social history of the area. Only a few minutes down the road at the Columbia Icefield, board a Brewster Ice Explorer and travel onto the icy slopes of the Athabasca Glacier. This excursion allows you to travel in a specially designed Brewster Ice Explorer to the middle of the glacier while the driver/guide explains how the glaciers are formed and points out interesting geological features **(Ice Explorer included)**. The ice is 365 metres (1,200 feet) thick - about the height of the Empire State Building. At the icefall below the glacial headwall, take the option of stepping out onto the ice formed from snow that fell 400 years ago. After your unique ice adventure, time is allowed at the Columbia Icefield Discovery Centre, to relax over lunch **(included)** and visit the new and expanded Parks Canada Interpretive Centre. In the afternoon, continue to Lake Louise, the "Jewel of the Rockies." After a short picture stop, arrive into Banff for the evening.

### Day 5 - Banff to Kamloops (B, L)

This morning, transfer **(included)** to the Banff Train Station and board Rocky Mountaineer's daylight train for a two-day journey through the Rockies. **Complimentary breakfast and lunch are served at your seat.** Complimentary snacks and non-alcoholic beverages are also provided. Today, travel across the Continental Divide, through Yoho National Park and the famous Spiral Tunnels. Before arriving into Kamloops, pass Craigellachie, where the "last spike" was driven, completing the Canadian Pacific Railway in 1885. Upon arrival in Kamloops, you will be transferred **(included)** to your hotel.

**Overnight in Kamloops**

### Day 6 - Kamloops to Vancouver (B, L)

Early this morning, transfer **(included)** to the Kamloops Train Station and re-board the Rocky Mountaineer daylight train for the journey to Vancouver. **Breakfast and lunch are once again served at your seat.** Today, begin following the Thompson River through the stark, arid beauty of the interior of British Columbia. Pass the raging turbulence of Hell's Gate, where millions of gallons of water per minute rush through the narrowest point of the Fraser Canyon. Before reaching the coastal city of Vancouver, travel through the final range of mountains, the Pacific Coast Mountains and into the fertile fields of the Fraser Valley. Upon arrival at the Vancouver train station, transfer via taxi to your selected hotel **(taxi transfer included)**.

### Day 7 - Vancouver Departure

Transfer from your hotel to the Vancouver International Airport **(transfer not included)** for your homeward or onward flight by a taxi or limousine.

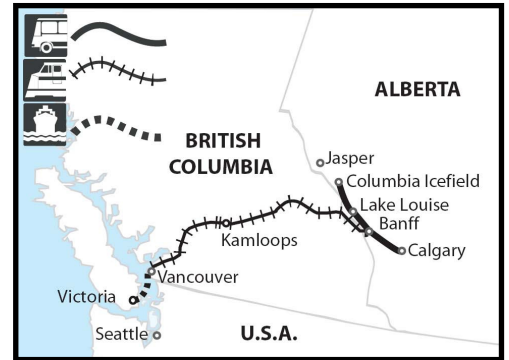

# Vancouver, Victoria & The Canadian Rockies

## from Vancouver Itinerary

### Day 1 - Vancouver

Upon arrival at the Vancouver International Airport, transfer independently, by city transit, limousine or taxi to downtown Vancouver **(transfer not included)**. **Overnight in Vancouver**

### Day 2 - Vancouver to Victoria (Round Trip)

Today, enjoy a full-day sightseeing excursion to Victoria, the capital city of British Columbia. Travel through the rich farmland of the Fraser River delta, arriving at Tsawwassen, and board a B.C. Ferry for a ninety-minute journey through the Gulf islands to Vancouver Island. Leaving the ferry at Swartz Bay, drive south on Saanich Peninsula to the world-renowned Butchart Gardens **(admission included)**. This 20-hectare (50-acre) botanical showcase is famous for its skillful blending of rare and exotic plants and trees mixed with native flora in a colourful and authentic series of formal gardens joined by several paths. Additional sightseeing highlights include the University of Victoria, Royal Victorian Yacht Club, Beacon Hill Park and the attractions of Victoria's Inner Harbour. You will have some leisure time in Victoria to explore on your own. Late this afternoon, transfer to the Swartz Bay ferry terminal and once again board a B.C. Ferry bound for a relaxing voyage through the Gulf Islands, renowned for their picturesque landscapes and seascapes and particularly for their rustic character. Occasionally, killer whales can be seen from the ship's decks. Upon arrival in Tsawwassen, transfer to Vancouver and your hotel **(transfer included)**. **Overnight in Vancouver**

### Day 3 - Vancouver

A morning sightseeing excursion is an introduction to the natural beauty of Vancouver's spectacular setting. Visit historic Gastown, bustling Chinatown, the tall timbers and ocean views of the 400-hectare (1000-acre) Stanley Park. Additional sightseeing highlights include Prospect Point, Queen Elizabeth Park and the English Bay Beaches. Before returning to downtown, take in a panoramic view of the city from Little Mountain. The remainder of the day is at leisure. **Overnight in Vancouver**

### Day 4 - Vancouver to Kamloops (B, L)

This morning, transfer via taxi **(included)** to the Rocky Mountaineer Train Station and board the Rocky Mountaineer daylight train for a two-day journey to Banff. **Breakfast and lunch will be served at your seat**. Pass Hell's Gate, where millions of litres of water per minute rush through the narrowest point in the Fraser Canyon. By the time you reach Kamloops in the interior of British Columbia, you will have crossed into Canada's semi-arid desert. In Kamloops you will be transferred **(included)** to your hotel. **Overnight in Kamloops**

### Day 5 - Kamloops to Banff (B, L)

Early this morning, transfer to the Kamloops Train Station and re-board the Rocky Mountaineer daylight train. **Breakfast and lunch will once again be served at your seat**. Today travel through the vast ranchlands along the South Thompson River to Shuswap Lake with its 1600 km (994 miles) of shoreline. Pass Craigellachie, where the "last spike" was driven, completing the Canadian Pacific Railway in 1885 and enter Rogers Pass with its tunnels, snow sheds and glistening glaciers. The Kicking Horse River leads to the Kicking Horse Pass, the Spiral Tunnels and over the Continental Divide into Banff National Park and the resort town of Banff. Upon arrival at the Banff Train Station, transfer to your selected hotel **(transfer included)**. **Overnight in Banff**

### Day 6 - Banff to Columbia Icefield (Round Trip) (L)

Today's journey travels north along the famous Icefields Parkway, one of the most spectacular highways in North America. 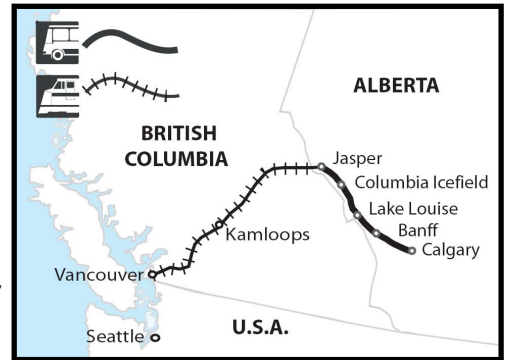

The walkway contains interpretive stations highlighting the ecology, geology, glaciology, Aboriginal history and social history of the area. Only a few minutes down the road at the Columbia Icefield, board a Brewster Ice Explorer and travel onto the icy slopes of the Athabasca Glacier. This excursion allows you to travel in a specially designed Brewster Ice Explorer to the middle of the glacier while the driver/guide explains how the glaciers are formed and points out interesting geological features (**Ice Explorer included**). The ice is 365 metres (1,200 feet) thick - about the height of the Empire State Building. At the icefall below the glacial headwall, take the option of stepping out onto the ice formed from snow that fell 400 years ago. After your unique ice adventure, time is allowed at the Columbia Icefield Discovery Centre, to relax over lunch (**included**) and visit the new and expanded Parks Canada Interpretive Centre. In the afternoon, continue to Lake Louise, the "Jewel of the Rockies". **Overnight in Lake Louise**

### Day 6 - Lake Louise to Banff
